

Policy on the Use of Electronic Devices

Recognizing the fundamental role that communications technology plays in our daily lives, it is important for the Rockaway Hunting Club to establish a clear policy for the use of electronic devices that strikes the right balance between our traditions and the realities of the times.

The use of electronic devices, including cellphones, smartphones, tablets and laptop computers at the Rockaway Hunting Club is limited, as follows:

- Use of electronic devices to text, email and check voicemail is permitted in locker rooms.
- In addition to the electronic communications mentioned above, phone calls may also be conducted in guest and annex rooms, the first floor phone booth, the Teak Room, inside parked vehicles, on the bench outside the tennis shop and in the gravel area immediately outside the men's locker room on the Ocean Avenue side (cell phone usage is no longer permissible in parking lot areas).
- Laptop computers are only permitted in guest and annex rooms and in the Teak Room.
- Tablets, Kindles and other similar electronic readers are permitted throughout the clubhouse, back porch and the screened patio for reading purposes only.
- The use of electronic devices is not permitted on the golf course, tennis courts or the skeet range.
- Photos may be taken with electronic devices although discretion is advised.
- Electronic devices should be on "vibrate" or "silent" mode at all times.

Members are asked to advise their children and their guests of this policy. Please be advised that staff members are being asked to enforce the guidelines and we ask that you politely adhere to their requests.
